3. BEFORE ENROLLMENT:

- Complete the Statement of Legal Residence form http://www2.reg.uci.edu/slr/
- Ensure that all official transcripts and AP exam scores have been received by the UCI Office of Admissions.
- Make copies of the AP scores if applicable and college transcripts and bring them to orientation. Proof of scores may be required for enrollment in certain courses.
- **PURCHASE:** Your 2007-08 UCI General Catalogue available at the UCI Bookstore and read the section pertaining to the School of Social Sciences. Bring it to your advising session for reference.
- **UCInetID:** All UCI students are assigned a University e-mail account (UCInetID). To be able to use your account, you must activate your UCInetID by going to http://ucinetid1.nacs.uci.edu/activate/menu.html.

NOTE: You will need an activated UCInetID to enroll in classes.

- 4. PAY FEES: All student billing must be accessed via the e-billing system at http://sbs.adcom.uci.edu/ZA/. Fees must be received by the Cashier's Office by September 21st at 4:30pm to maintain your enrollment. If the payment is late, you will be dropped from all your classes.
- 5. **DOUBLE CHECK:** Access WebReg during the week of September 21st to verify course enrollments, times, and locations.
- 6. **WELCOME WEEK:** September 24th through September 26th is "UCI's Welcome Week". Below are some important events:
 - Monday, September 24th: School of Social Sciences Dean's Welcome in SSLH 100 and then the UCI Anteater Club Fair and BBQ in Aldrich Park.
 - Get your UCI Student ID card from UCItems located in a trailer behind the UCI Student Center.
 - Buy your course books at the UCI Bookstore.
 - Instruction begins on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>September 27th</u>.
