- CV/Resume (5 pages maximum)
- One Letter of recommendation from honors thesis mentor

Note: If you desire, you may choose to obtain Letters of Recommendation from persons other than those listed in "Faculty Reference" section above. Although letters will be accepted from non-faculty (ie: T.A.s or staff) it is highly recommended that you obtain your letters from regular faculty members. Provide your name and UCI identification number on all documents.
