Specialization in International Issues and Economics

Admission to the specialization requires advance approval by the Economics Department. Students interested in pursuing the specialization must complete an application available from the Department office (SSPB 3223/3229) after the completion of Econ 20A-B. The application must be filed NO LATER than the end of junior

Students in the Honors Program must complete an honors thesis during the two-quarter Honors Colloquium:
