Change of Major Requirements

ANTHROPOLOGY, CHICANO/LATINO STUDIES, INTERNATIONAL STUDIES, POLITICAL SCIENCE, AND SOCIAL POLICY & PUBLIC SERVICE

Students more than 60 units:

- Completion of 5 School of Social Sciences courses, 2 must be from the intended major. They must have an average GPA of 2.0, no grade less than a "C".
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0.

Students less than 60 units:

- Completion of 2 courses from the intended major, with an average GPA of 2.3, no grade less than a "C".
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0.

PSYCHOLOGY (B.A.)

Option A:

- Completion of 2 Psychology courses with at least a "B-" in each course. One course must be Psych 7A, 9A, 9B, or 9C.
- Cumulative GPA of 2.7.

Option B:

- Completion of Psych 9A-B-C and 2 core courses with an average GPA of at least 3.0 in these 5 courses.
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0.

BUSINESS ECONOMICS, ECONOMICS, AND QUANTITATIVE ECONOMICS

- Completion of Math 2A-B and Econ 20A-B with an average GPA of 2.5 with no grade less than a "C".
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0.

SOCIOLOGY

- Completion of 5 School of Social Science courses, 2 must be in Sociology, with an average GPA of 2.3. No grade must be less than a "C".
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0.

COGNITIVE SCIENCES (B.S.)

- Completion of Math 2A, Math 2B, Stats 7, and either ICS 31 or Psych 114M with no grade less than a "C+".
- Completion of Psych 9A, 9B, and 9C with no grade less than a "C+".
- Students must maintain an overall GPA of 3.0 for all courses in the major.
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0.

- ❖ **All students must have a quarterly GPA of at least 2.0 in the preceding quarter.**
- ❖ **All requirements must be completed prior to changing major.**

Students with senior standing (135+ units) who wish to change their major will have their files reviewed. For those considering adding a double major, it is encouraged that you provide an academic plan on how both majors will be completed in a timely manner.
