◆Specialization in International Issues and Economics

Students in any of the three Economics majors may complete the specialization in "International Issues and Economics." To declare the specialization, fill out a "Degreeworks Update Form" with the Social Sciences Undergraduate Student Affairs Office.

Requirements for the Specialization:

В.	THREE Upper Division International Economics elective courses chosen from: Economics 157, 161B, 162, 164A,165, 167
C.	THREE International electives (only ONE may be lower-division) chosen from: Int'l Studies 111C, 112A, 114A, 114D, 121, 122, 123, 179 (when focus is on international economy); Political Science 141B, 141C; History 21A, B, C.
NOTE:	*NO MORE THAN 2 courses may overlap between the major and the specialization requirements. *Students pursuing this specialization MAY NOT double major or minor in International Studies. *The Department encourages students to take the electives for this specialization while studying in the Education Abroad Program (EAP): Study Abroad Center (Student Services II 1100; 824-6343).
